


## Viewing the BLM 3D Gallery

## About this exhibit


This exhibit is a curated documentary presentation of street artworks on view in public, and they display the relationships of the street art to their immediate environment. The relationships are a dimension of the artworks' status as *protest*, and the presentation critiques the presumptive nature of the conventionally exposed urban landscape.
